




Co-created education

Communities of Practice

- Learning is not you one a small island- it is an integrated part of practice in a context.
- The group or communities define themselves through the doing or activity of the participants
 - how the members develop knowledge
 - the mutual understanding of the community's practice

Learning is not an isolated phenomena, but embedded in sociocultural cultures and practices. Through the <u>mutual engagement</u>, relationships tie the <u>members together and learning occurs</u>. The practices which is making up the community might be <u>formalised as well as being informal</u>. However, wherever we are we are partakers, to different degrees, in different communities, that is- in the family, in the neighbourhood, at work, in sports, with friends and so on.

Describing the learning process

Peripheral participation- the newcomer's way to becoming an expert

 Through the attainment of knowledge and through the practice in the community the members move towards the core with the goal of full participation.

• Examples: becoming a pupil, getting a new job, playing an instrument, becoming a carpenter




The green and purple part illustrates what your possibilities for learning is.
