

What's the cost of living in Hólar, Iceland?

The Icelandic public universities (including Hólar University) charge a registration fee of IS Krona 75.000,- per academic year.

As a student you will need a minimum of approximately ISK 138.000,- per month in order to cover your basic expenses when living in rural Iceland¹.

To give you an idea of the living expenses for a student at Hólar University, we have put together a modest budget for **one month** (all numbers are approximate):

Housing	ISK 55.000 (Single room, incl. elect./heating)²
Food	ISK 37.000
Books & Supplies	ISK 10.000
Transport	ISK 15.000
Internet and mobile services	ISK 6.000
Miscellaneous	ISK 15.000

The price of transport and housing might be different depending on locations of individual students during the Practicum as at least some students will be located in other places in Iceland than at Hólar campus during the period of that course.
